Announcement of opening the Individual Participant Data Sharing Platform for public use

The International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE) published a statement for sharing individual data at 20 Jan. 2016, in which the Individual Participant data (IPD) was required to be able to access for sharing within 6 months after the trial completed (1).

Chinese Clinical Trial Registry betake to promote the clinical trial transparency, to enhance the management level and quality. For this mission, we will provide a public service of opening IPD sharing platform from 12 September, 2016.

The IPD sharing platform is a branch platform of ResMan, both of them are independent from Chinese Clinical Trial Registry.

After logon the ResMan, a selection window provides a way to the IPD sharing platform. The IPD sharing platform is a deposit and sharing platform, unable to establish a clinical trial management database.

The ways for Sharing IPD:

1. Researcher making decision and manage the time point of opening and sharing, after selection of “open”, public will be able to freely take look and download the IPD;
2. The time of upload IPD is the opening time, selection of “not open” which means that public have to has a trial’s IPD should to contact the researcher, after approved by the researcher, one can get IPD.

Charge for use of IPD sharing platform:
